The NZ - UK Link Foundation creates and promotes educational and cultural exchanges between New Zealand and the United Kingdom. It seeks to encourage talent and the exchange of knowledge, and to heighten awareness of what each country has to offer the other.

#### **Eligibility**

Anyone may apply for a NZ-UK Link Foundation Fellowship if he/she is a citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand. The person must be in a position, on completion of the Fellowship, to communicate his/her experiences to interested groups.

#### **Conditions**

Fellows will be expected to agree in writing to the conditions under which the award is granted. They will be required to provide receipts for major expenditure, and a written report within one month of the Fellowship ending. They will acknowledge the NZ-UK Link Foundation as a sponsor in any publicity material. They will undertake any agreed speaking or other engagements for the NZ-UK Link Foundation on their return to New Zealand to facilitate the exchange of knowledge. They will also undertake to refund all of the Fellowship, or an amount determined by the selection committee, if they fail to comply, in whole or in part, with the conditions of the award.

Applicants are required to provide the names and contact details of two (2) confidential referees.

An award will not normally be granted in association with any other grant or Fellowship.
